Introduction

An air of realism pervades today's readings. Taking up the cross and following Jesus is a costly undertaking. It may lead to loss of possessions, perhaps even the loss of life itself. Yet he promises a great reward to those who have the courage to follow in his steps.

HEADING FOR READINGS

First Reading (Wis 9:13-18). The author reminds us that we are frail, limited human beings who will never be able to understand all of the mysteries of life. Only God's Wisdom can instruct us.

Second Reading (Philemon 9-10.12-17). Paul appeals to the Christian commitment of his friend Philemon and asks him to take back his runaway slave and treat him with love as his brother in Christ.

Gospel (Lk 14:25-33). If we wish to be disciples of Jesus, we must be ready to give up everything to follow him as he walks the way of the cross.

from one generation to the next.**
